Turnover rates are the percentages of teachers employed in one year in a district, but not employed in the district in the following year, averaged over four years from 2001 to 2004. Out of field rates are the percentages of teachers in each district assigned to teach subjects for which they do not hold a standard teaching certificate, averaged over four years from 2001 to 2004.

Student enrollment is the student membership in each district for 2002-2003 as reported by TEA in AEIS. Community type is the classification of each district as reported by TEA in PEIMS. Individual campuses that act as their own LEAs, such as charter schools, are not included.
