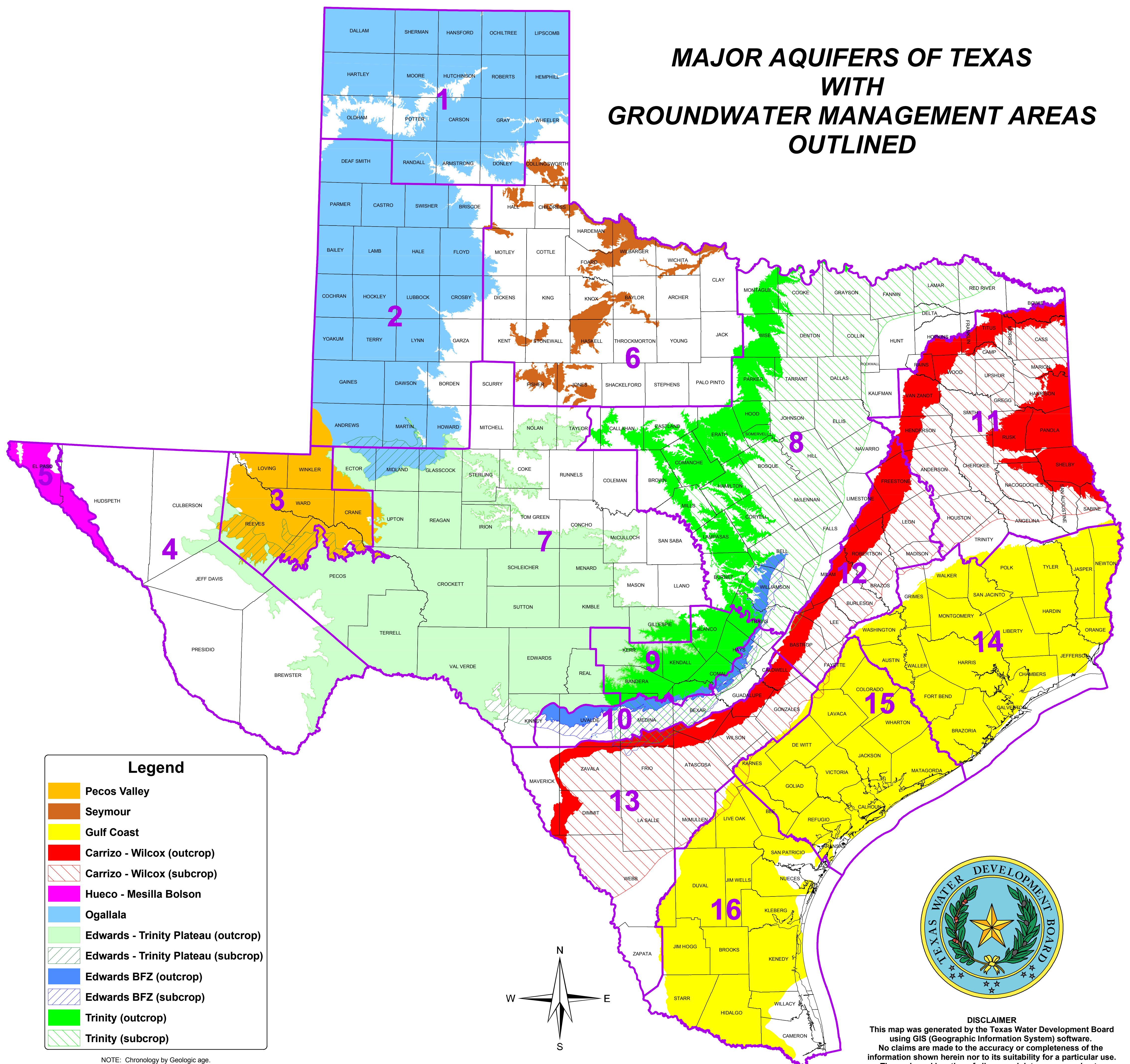


MAJOR AQUIFERS OF TEXAS WITH GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AREAS OUTLINED

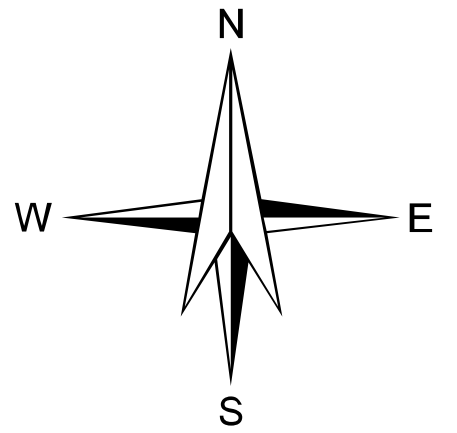
