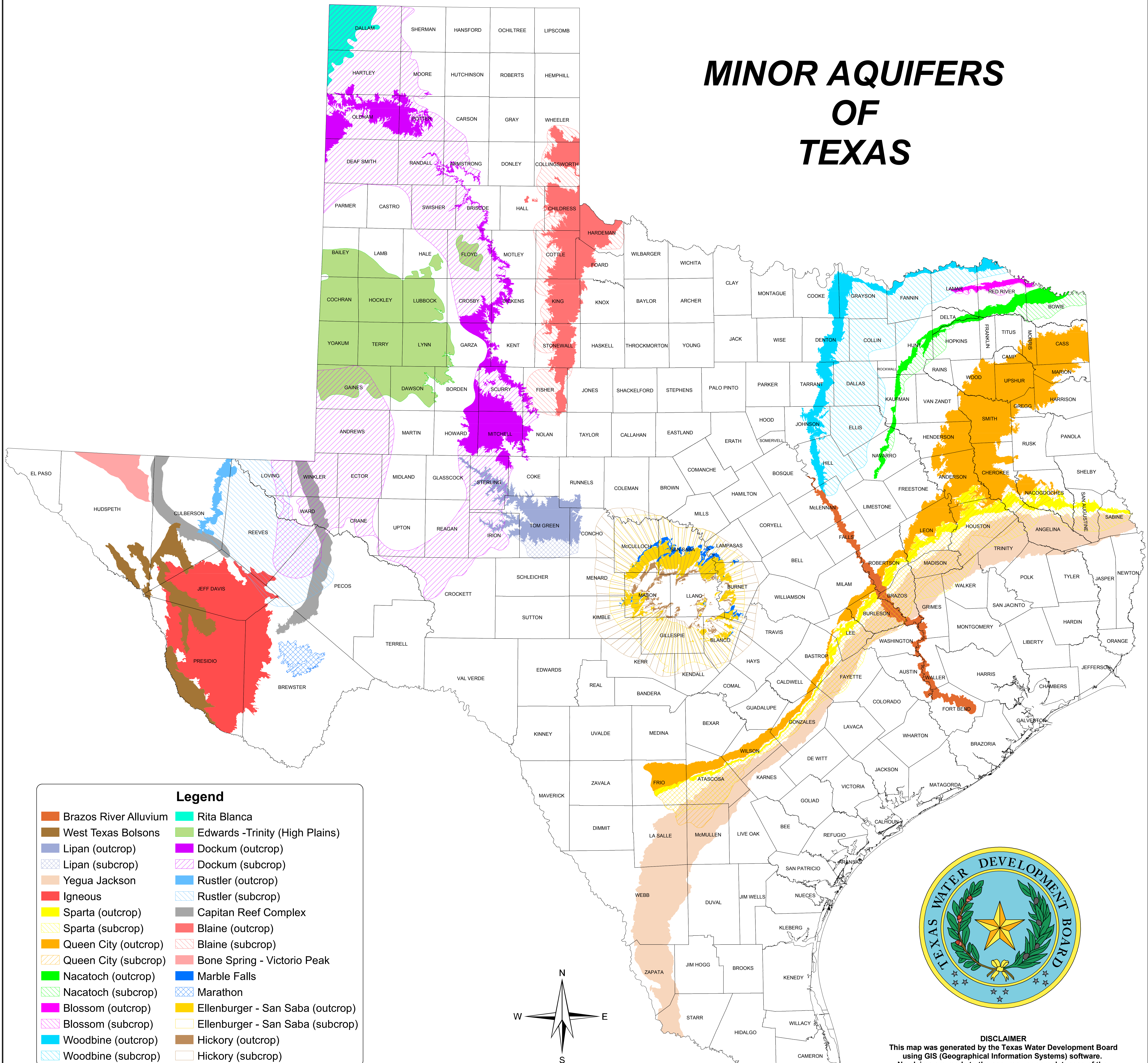


MINOR AQUIFERS OF TEXAS

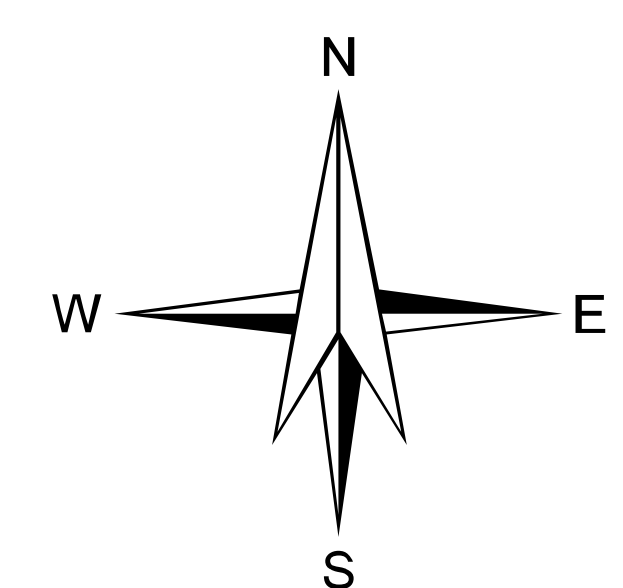
