Notes about Data for District Courts for FY 2006

At the time of publication, there was a 99.2 percent reporting rate overall for the fiscal year.

No reports were received for 2 months from Hays County, for 5 months from Hill County, for 8 months from Live Oak County, and for 10 months from Swisher County.

In addition, at the time of publication,

- Data submitted by Harris County for civil case activity was inaccurate.
 Most significantly, the number of *Other Cases Added* for the fiscal year under the **All Other Family Law Matters** category was extremely inflated, making the clearance rate for this category, as well as the overall civil case clearance rate, very low.
- Bexar County was incorrectly counting all motions in family law cases. The actual number of cases added for FY 2006 was 10,000 to 11,000 lower than the number published in the annual report.
- District court information reported for Hill County also contained statistics for the county court at law.
