

## Methodology for Estimating the Use of Child Care for Working Parents

### A. Estimated number of children 0-12 in center-based care = 762,582

*Methodology: Estimated number of children with a parent in the labor force multiplied by the estimated percent of children in center-based care (by age range).*

\*Center-based care = child care centers, Head Start, pre-k, preschool, and nursery school programs.

### B. Estimated number of adults in the labor force with children 0-12 in center-based care = 597,443

*Methodology: Estimated number of children 0-12 in center-based care with a parent in the labor force multiplied by the estimated ratio of adults to children 0-12 per household.*

Number of children in Texas 0-12	3,613,879	2000 Census
Avg. Number of Children 0-12 per Household	1.84	3,613,879 ÷ 1,964,989
Avg. Family Size	3.28	2000 Census
Est. number of adults per household	1.44	3.28 – 1.84
<b>Est. ratio of adults to children 0-12</b>	<b>.78</b>	<b>1.44 ÷ 1.84</b>
<b>Est. number of children 0-12 in center-based care with a parent in the labor force</b>	<b>762,582</b>	“A” above
<b>Est. number of adults in the labor force with children 0-12</b>	<b>597,443</b>	<b>.78 × 762,582</b>

### C. Estimated number of workers with children 0-12 in center-based care = 558,012

*Methodology: Adjust the estimated number of adults in the labor force with children 0-12 in center-based care by the Texas labor participation (employment) rate.*

Est. number of adults in the labor force with children 0-12 in center-based care	<b>597,443</b>	“B” above
Texas Employment Rate (2003)	93.4%	TWC LMI
Est. number of workers with children 0-12 in center-based child care	<b>558,012</b>	597,443 × 93.4%

### D. Estimated Annual Wages Generated by Workers with Children 0-12 in center-based care = \$14.5 billion

*Methodology: Median annual wage in Texas multiplied by the estimated number of workers with children 0-12 in center-based care.*

<b>Annual wages generated by workers with children 0-12 in center-based care</b>	<b>\$14,536,217,189</b>	<b>\$26,050 × 558,012</b>
