## Comments for August 2009

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the Dallas-Plano-Irving area declined by 7,100 jobs in August. Mining, Logging, and Construction employment experienced an over-the-month loss of 900 jobs. Financial Activities followed with a loss of 1,000 jobs for August. Despite the over the month losses, Retail Trade added 700 jobs in August. Education and Health Services closely followed with an increase of 500 jobs over the month. Since August 2008, the industry added 21,600 jobs, an annual growth rate of 9.4 percent. The majority of the employment increase occurred in Health Care and Social Assistance which grew by 13,100 jobs over the year. Professional and Business Services and Leisure and Hospitality each gained 300 jobs over the month. Local Government experienced an over-the-month loss of 800 jobs.
