





Comments for August 2009

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the El Paso MSA contracted by 1,000 jobs for the month of August. Mining, Logging, and Construction employment declined by 100 jobs over the month. Retail Trade employment experienced no over the month change. Education and Health Services increased by 200 jobs and gained 800 jobs or 2.4 percent since August 2008. Leisure and Hospitality decreased by 200 jobs or -0.7 percent in August. Total Government experienced an employment decrease of 800 jobs, mostly due to a loss of 600 jobs in Local Government. The El Paso MSA lost 3,500 jobs over the past year, representing an annual growth rate of -1.3 percent.
