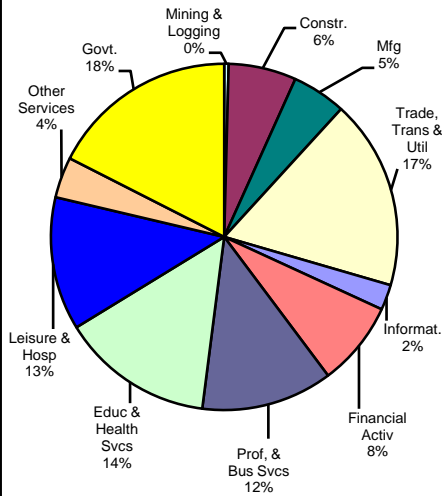
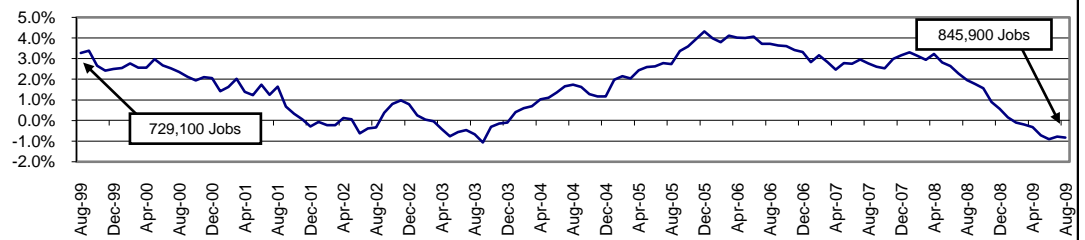


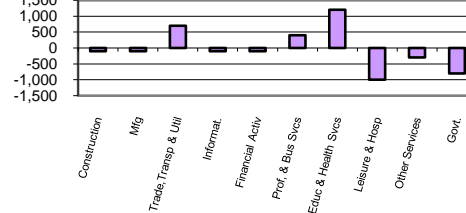
Industry Composition



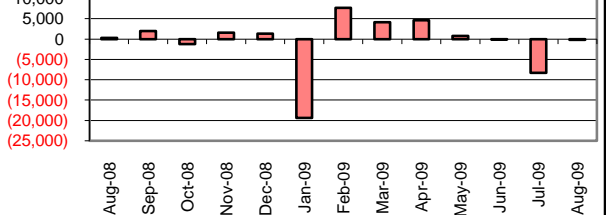
Annual Growth Rate for Total NonAgricultural Employment

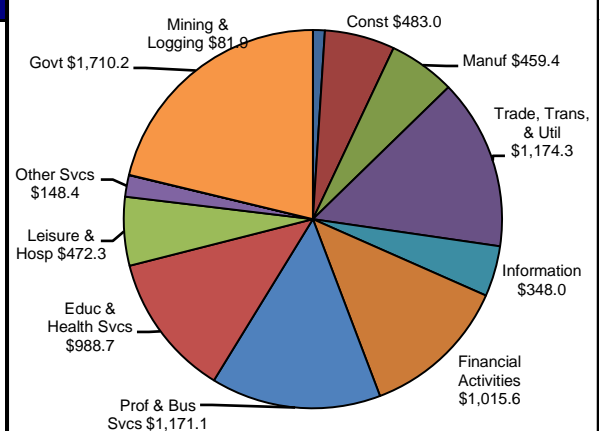

Comments for August 2009

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the San Antonio MSA dropped by 200 jobs in August. Since August 2008, the MSA lost 7,100 jobs or -0.8 percent. Employment in Manufacturing continued to decrease over the month as the industry posted a negative annual growth rate of -8.8 percent, a loss of 4,100 jobs. Retail Trade continued seasonal employment increases and posted a positive annual growth rate of 0.5 percent or an addition of 500 jobs. Professional and Business Services posted an over the month gain of 400 jobs and an annual growth rate of -3.0 percent, a loss of 3,200 jobs. Education and Health Services experienced an employment increase of 1,200 jobs as education related businesses began preparing for the upcoming school year. Leisure and Hospitality experienced a seasonal decline of 1,000 jobs and gained 600 jobs since August 2008, an annual growth rate of 0.6 percent. Government lost 800 jobs and gained 1,800 jobs since August 2008, an annual growth rate of 1.2 percent.
