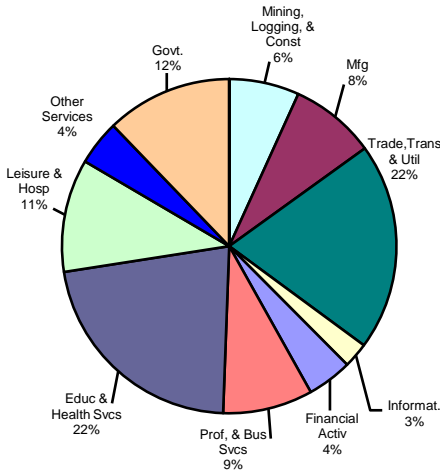
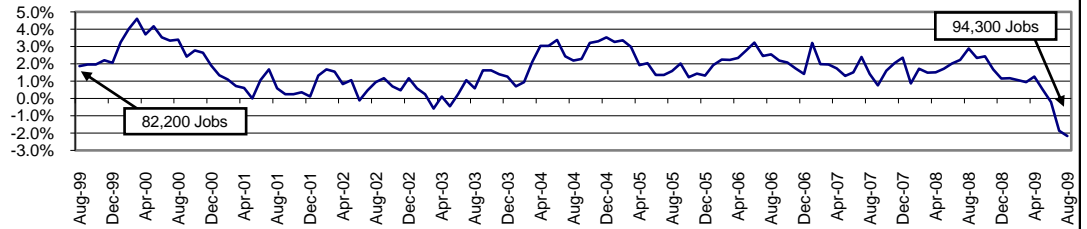


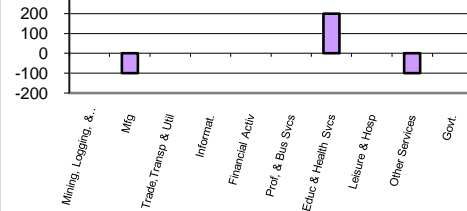
Industry Composition



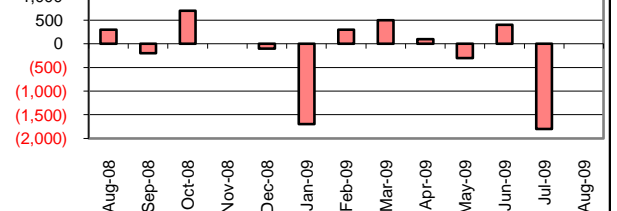
Annual Growth Rate for Total NonAgricultural Employment

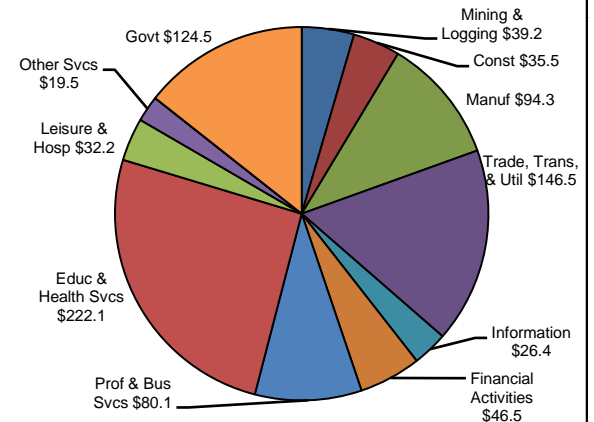

Comments for August 2009

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the Tyler MSA held steady in August, but lost 2,100 jobs for the year. Mining, Logging, and Construction remained constant for August and lost 200 jobs since August 2008. Manufacturing continued to decline with a loss of 100 jobs for August, and decreased by 1,100 positions in the past twelve months. Retail Trade, Financial Activities, Professional and Business Services, and Information held steady over the month. Education and Health Services added 200 jobs over the month and 300 positions since August 2008. Leisure and Hospitality employment remained constant over the month. Government employment had zero gains for August, and State Government grew by 100 jobs since August 2008.
