#### **PREFACE**

Beginning in 1913 with the first water agency in Texas, the Board of Water Engineers, and continuing through the tenure of the Texas Department of Water Resources, numerous agencies have administered the Constitution and laws of the State pertaining to the use, development, conservation, and protection of its surface-and-ground-water resources. On September 1, 1985, the 69th Legislature abolished the Department of Water Resources and divided State water administration into two agencies—the present Texas Water Development Board and the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission.

Presented herein is a bibliography containing a partly annotated list of all works published by the Texas Department of Water Resources and its predecessor agencies through August 1985 and a completely annotated list of works published by the Texas Water Development Board since September 1, 1985. Many of the publications contained within this listing are still in print; new publications will continue to be published by both the Texas Water Development Board and the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission, although this catalog will only include TWDB publications. The Hydrologic Monitoring Section of the TWDB intends to update this bibliography and its county index yearly.

#### **B**ULLETINS

Bulletins typically present the results of long-term or extensive investigations, often covering a large region, a county, or the state. Bulletins prior to February 1962 were published by the Texas Board of Water Engineers (Bulletins 5001 through 6202); from February 1962 through August 1965, they were published by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (Bulletins 6203 through 6521). From September 1965 through August 1985, these publications were continued in the Report Series by the Texas Department of Water Resources.

#### **CIRCULARS**

Circulars contain information that is introductory, brief, and less technical or detailed than is contained in the other publication series. They are usually issued in brochure or pamphlet form.

#### **GENERAL PUBLICATIONS**

General Publications include several categories, each of which is mandated by federal or state law. The categories are: (l) rules and procedures, (2) biennial reports, (3) standards and procedures, and (4) major planning documents.

#### **Hydrologic Atlases**

This series, begun in 1990 by the Ground Water Section of the TWDB, was initiated to publish maps illustrating specific groundwater conditions affecting all or large portions of the state.

#### Intensive Monitoring Surveys

Intensive Monitoring Survey Reports provide information on specific stream segments for the following purposes: (l) to determine quantitative cause and effect relationships of water–quality; (2) to update water-quality management plans, set effluent limits, and verify the classification of segments where appropriate; (3) to set priorities for establishing or improving pollution controls; and (4) to determine any additional water-quality management actions required. In 1979, these reports were superseded by the Intensive Survey Series.

#### **INTENSIVE SURVEYS**

This series is a continuation of the preceding Intensive Monitoring Survey Reports.

#### LIMITED DISTRIBUTION REPORTS

These reports were published by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission from 1962 to 1965. In general, the reports deal with specific problems within a small area and therefore were printed in small quantities for limited distribution. These reports are similar to the Memorandum Reports.

#### LIMITED PRINTING

Collectively, this series of publications spans a broad range of information needs. They are frequently prepared to address problems in specific areas, cities, or wells, and often have a limited printing because of interest to a limited population. Many of these are published to summarize findings of short-term work.

#### MEMORANDUM REPORTS

Memorandum Reports were published in 1962 and 1963 by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission. Information in this series is similar to that in Limited Distribution Reports.

#### MISCELLANEOUS PUBLICATIONS

These publications were not issued as a series. They have been alphabetized by county, city, area, or key subject word and assigned numbers and the letter prefix M for Bibliographic identity. These are very early publications of predecessor agencies of the Texas Water Development Board and the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission and cover a wide variety of topics.

#### PLANNING REPORTS

Planning documents were published by predecessor agencies of the Texas Water Development Board and the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission. These were not published as a designated series and have been assigned numbers and the letter prefix P for bibliographic identity. One major Planning Report by the Texas Department of Water Resources was published in the General Publication Series.

#### REPORTS

This series is a continuation of the earlier Bulletin Series. These were published by the Texas Water Development Board from September 1965 through August 1977 (Reports 1 - 213), and by the Texas Department of Water Resources from September 1977 through August 1985 (Reports 214 - 292). This type of report constitutes the bulk of the work published by the Texas Water Development Board since September 1985.

#### SPECIAL REPORTS

Special Reports pertain to the quality of surface water and were published by the Texas Water Quality Board from September 1967 through August 1977.

#### USER'S MANUALS

These publications are typically user's reference manuals for automated data and information systems. These manuals describe the characteristics of the systems and the procedures to follow in using them. Written in user-oriented terminology, these publications usually contain examples of input documents, descriptions of the computer processing, and samples of output products. Because numerous systems were developed under cooperative agreements with other state agencies, many of the user's manuals pertain to topics that are unrelated to water.

#### WATER QUALITY SEGMENT REPORTS

Water Quality Segment Reports describe prevailing water quality in a specific stream segment and provide a basis for decision making in the continuing effort to maintain and improve the quality of Texas surface waters. Each report contains information on stream quality, wastewater discharges, water-quality problems, and an historical perspective on improvement in water quality.

#### **BIENNIAL REPORTS**

These publications are Biennial reports of the Texas Water Development Board covering the period September 1, 1964 through August 31, 1977. These were not published as a designated series and have been assigned numbers and the prefix X for bibliographic identity. Biennial Reports published by the Texas Department of Water Resources are listed in the General Publications Series. Published Biennial reports of Additional Predecessor agencies (Texas Board of Water Engineers, Texas Water Quality Board, Texas Water Rights Commission, and Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission) covering the period 1913 to 1977 are also available for reference in the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission's Water Resources Library. The latest Biennial Report, published by the Texas Water Development Board, is listed in the Limited Printing Series.
