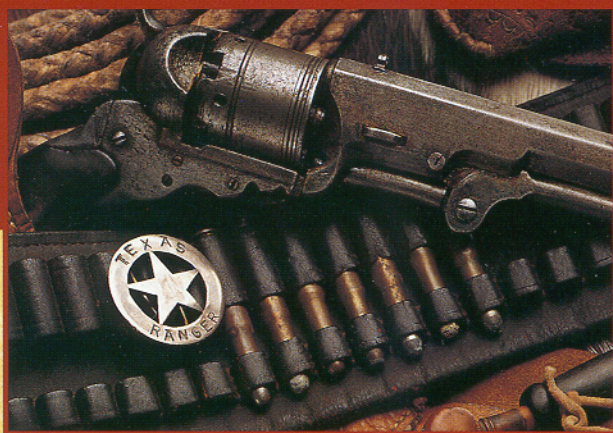

The Texas Ranger Hall of Fame and Museum complex is dedicated to the history and lore of the legendary Texas Rangers—the oldest state law enforcement agency in the nation and an enduring symbol of Texas and the American West.

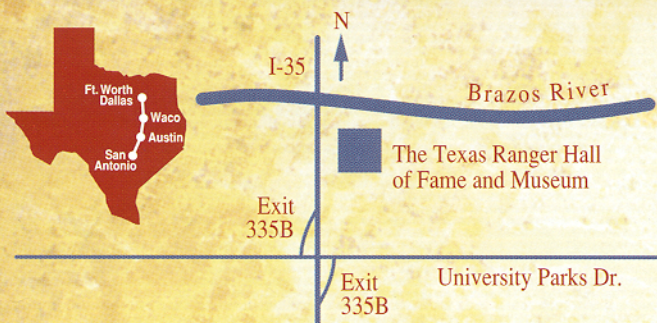
The Homer Garrison Museum houses the largest existing collection of artifacts related to the Texas Rangers, some dating back to their Spanish and Mexican origins. Among the treasures are Texas Ranger badges, firearms, tack, and personal gear; the weapons and possessions of notorious outlaws Bonnie & Clyde; a Bowie Knife owned by Jim Bowie; famed Billy-the-Kid's 1873 Winchester Carbine and the shotgun he used to escape from the Lincoln County, New Mexico jail.

The Hall of Fame memorializes Texas Rangers who gave their lives in the line of duty or served with great distinction.

The Moody Texas Ranger Memorial Library contains books, archives, photographs and oral histories related to the Texas Rangers.

The Texas Ranger Hall of Fame is located in Waco, Texas (midway between Dallas and Austin) at Interstate-35, Exit 335B in Fort Fisher Park.

THE TEXAS RANGER LEGEND LIVES ON



The Texas Ranger Hall of Fame is operated as a public educational department of the City of Waco.

Historic Waco on the old Chisholm Trail, was founded in 1849 by a former Texas Ranger. The City offers museums and attractions for every taste – the Dr Pepper Museum (the famous soft drink invented in Waco), Texas Sports Hall of Fame, historic antebellum homes, Armstrong-Browning Library, Strecker Museum of natural history, Gov. Bill and Vara Daniel Historic Village, Taylor Museum of Waco History, the 1870 Suspension Bridge over the Brazos River and the Art Center of Waco.
