The 77<sup>8</sup> Legislature passed a law permitting convicted persons to submit a motion to the convicting court for forensic DNA testing of evidence containing biological material. After holding a hearing, the convicting court makes a finding as to whether the results are favorable to the convicting person. If the person was convicted in a capital case, an appeal of the convicting court's finding is a direct appeal to the Court of Criminal Appeals. (Texas Code of Criminal Procedure art. 64.05, effective April 5, 2001.)

Original proceedings are filed directly with the Court of Criminal Appeals, Applications for writ of habeas corpus, although seeking relief from the Court of Criminal Appeals, must be filed in the trial court, which has 35 days in which to submit findings of fact, conclusions of law, and a recommendation to the Court of Criminal Appeals.

Motions for extensions of time to file transcripts of court reporter's notes, bill of exceptions, briefs and petitions for discretionary review.
