



# CHILD SUPPORT EVADER STEPHEN McCAA

ATTORNEY GENERAL GREG ABBOTT needs your help locating Child Support Evader Stephen McCaa, one of the Most Wanted Child Support Evaders in Texas. McCaa, who was added to the Child Support Evader's list in August 2008, owes \$20,147 for the care of two children living with their grandparents in a small town outside Lufkin.

In July 2003, an Angelina County judge ordered McCaa to pay \$320 a month in current child support, plus \$80 a month against \$8,000 owed to the grandparents for care they provided back to 2001. McCaa, who had the ability to make his payments, did not follow the judge's order to support his children financially.

By September 2005, McCaa owed more than \$14,000 in unpaid child support. An arrest warrant was issued after he failed to appear at an enforcement

hearing to address his noncompliance.

By refusing to provide the financial resources his children need, McCaa has turned his back on them and violated the law. A combination of missed payments and interest that accrues on unpaid child support adds up to more than \$20,000 in unpaid child support McCaa now owes.

Investigators from the Office of the Attorney General have searched the state for McCaa. He may be living in Wells, a small town in Cherokee County northwest of Lufkin; and could be working for cash to avoid garnishment of wages to pay child support. The Child Support Evaders are being singled out because they have the ability to take responsibility for their children, but refuse to do so. Incarceration is the only option for parents who flagrantly ignore a court's order to pay child support. ## POINTS TO REMEMBER



### MOST WANTED EVADERS

For a parent to be named as a Most Wanted Child Support Evader:

- Court-ordered delinquent support must be in excess of \$5,000
- Arrest warrant must have been issued for non-support
- Location of non-custodial parent is unknown
- Parent has not made any payments in the last six months
- Non-custodial parent must not be involved in bankruptcy proceedings
- Non-custodial parent must not be receiving welfare benefits

In order to make child support information public, the custodial parent must sign a confidentiality waiver.
