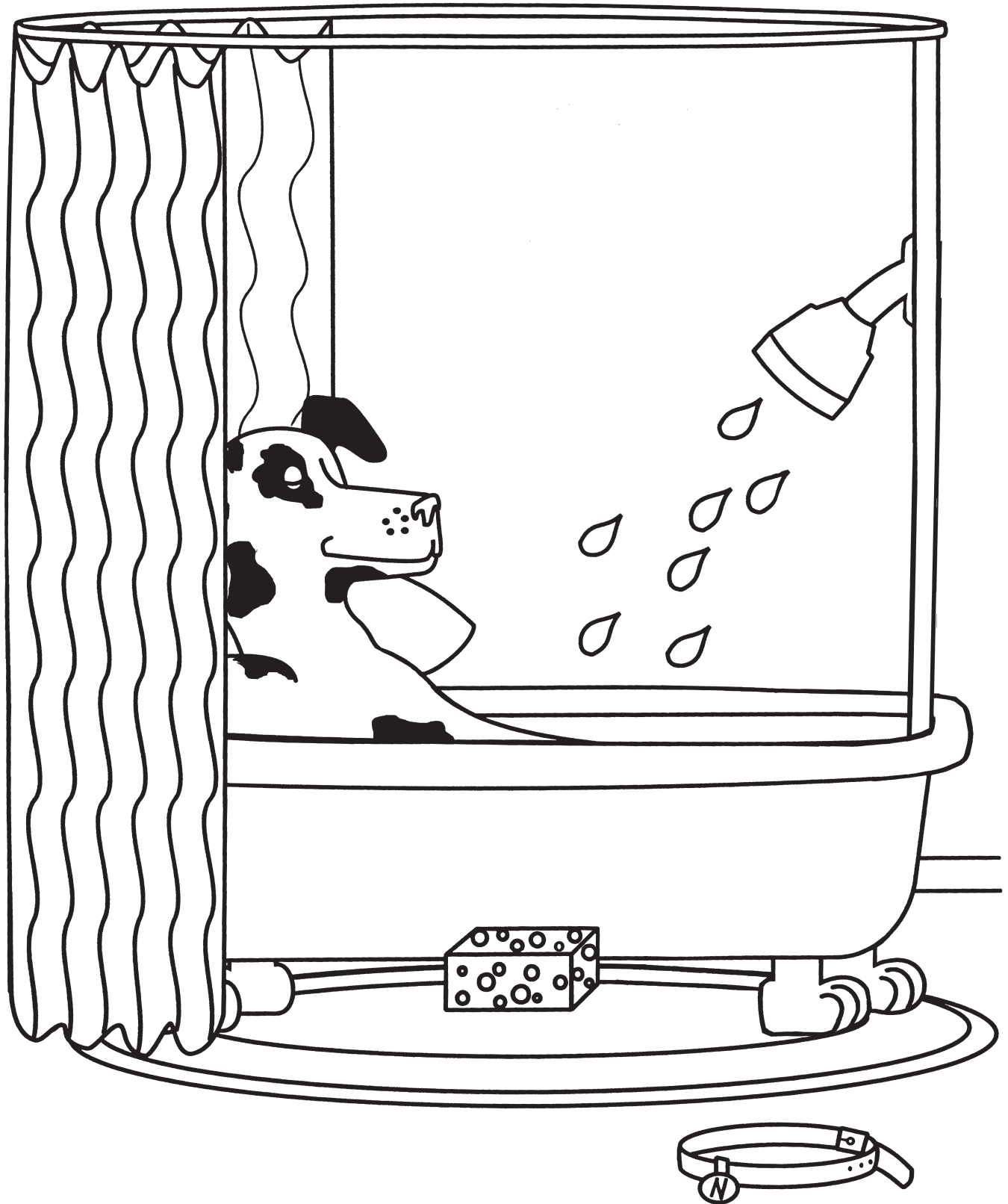
Sam tells Neighbor Ned...

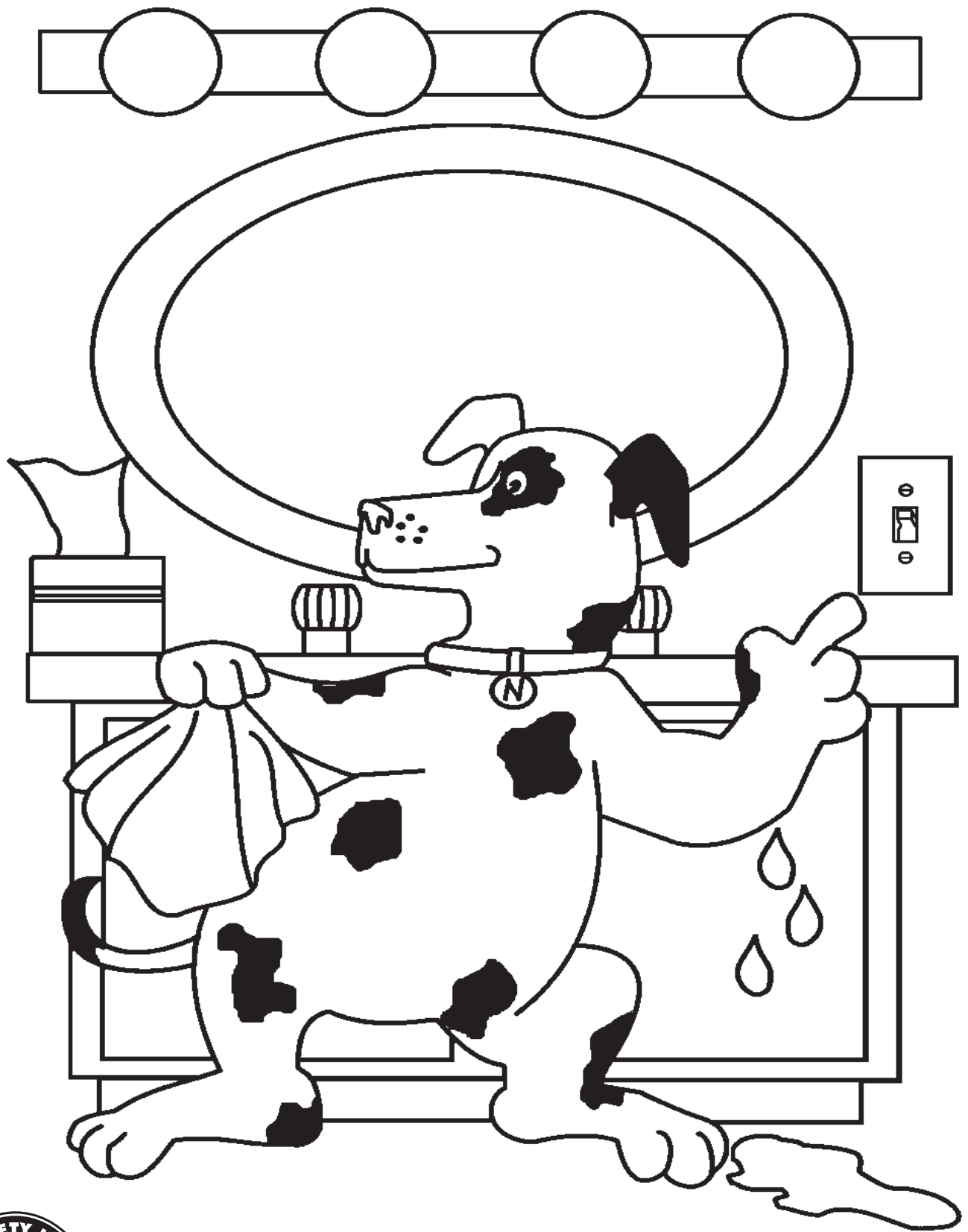


Sam tells Neighbor Ned...

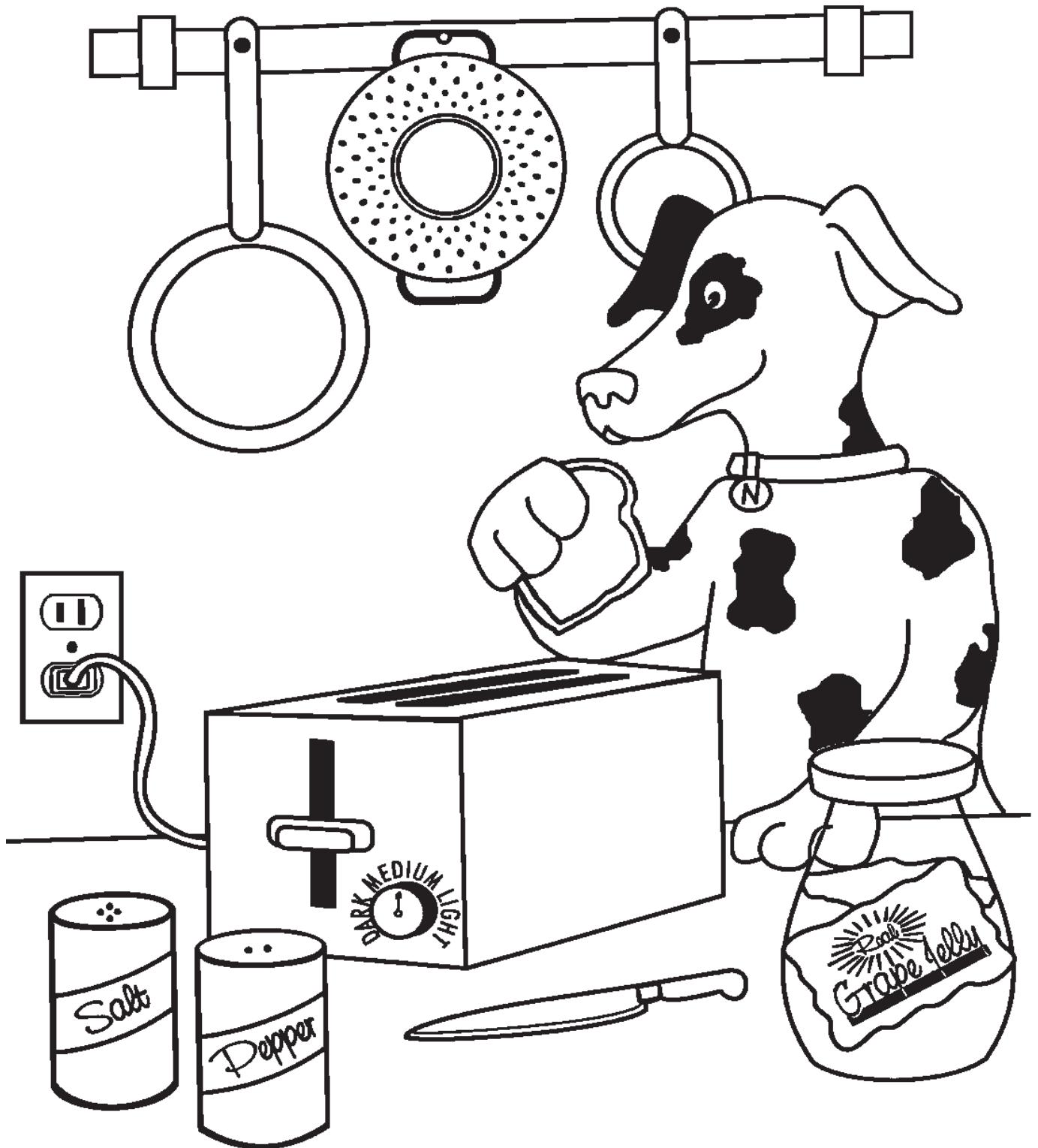


Sam tells Neighbor Ned...

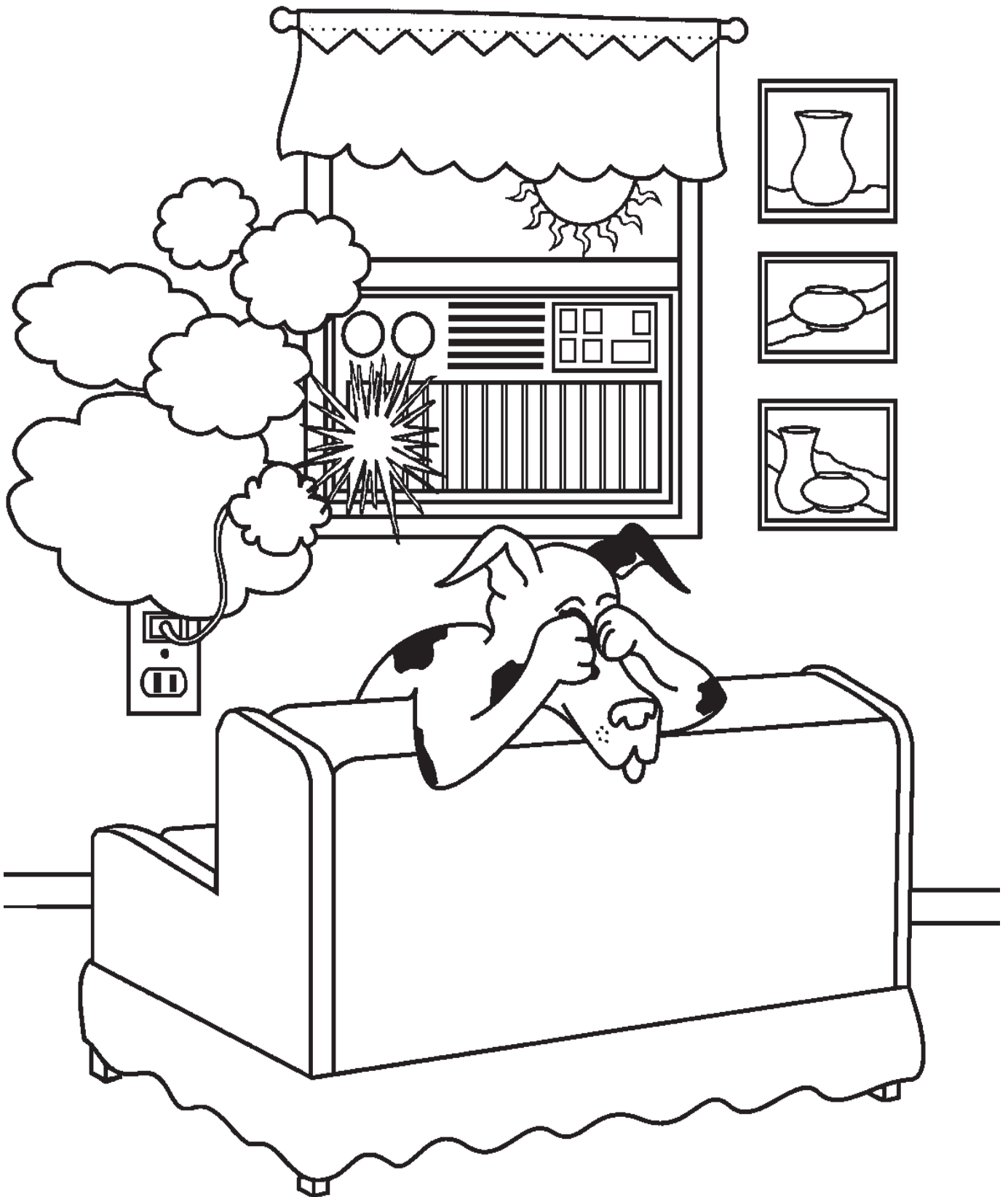
Sam tells Neighbor Ned...

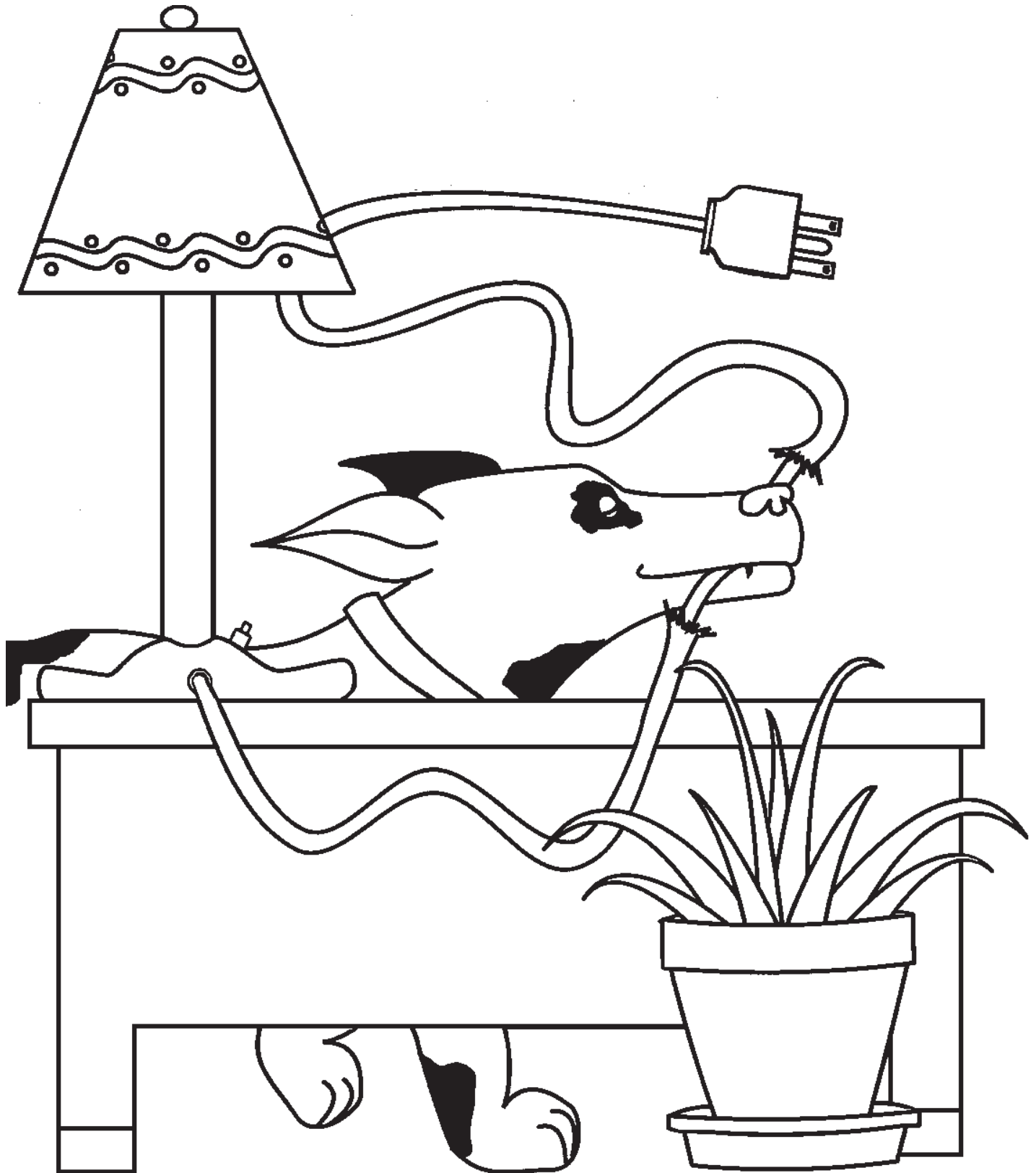


Sam tells Neighbor Ned...

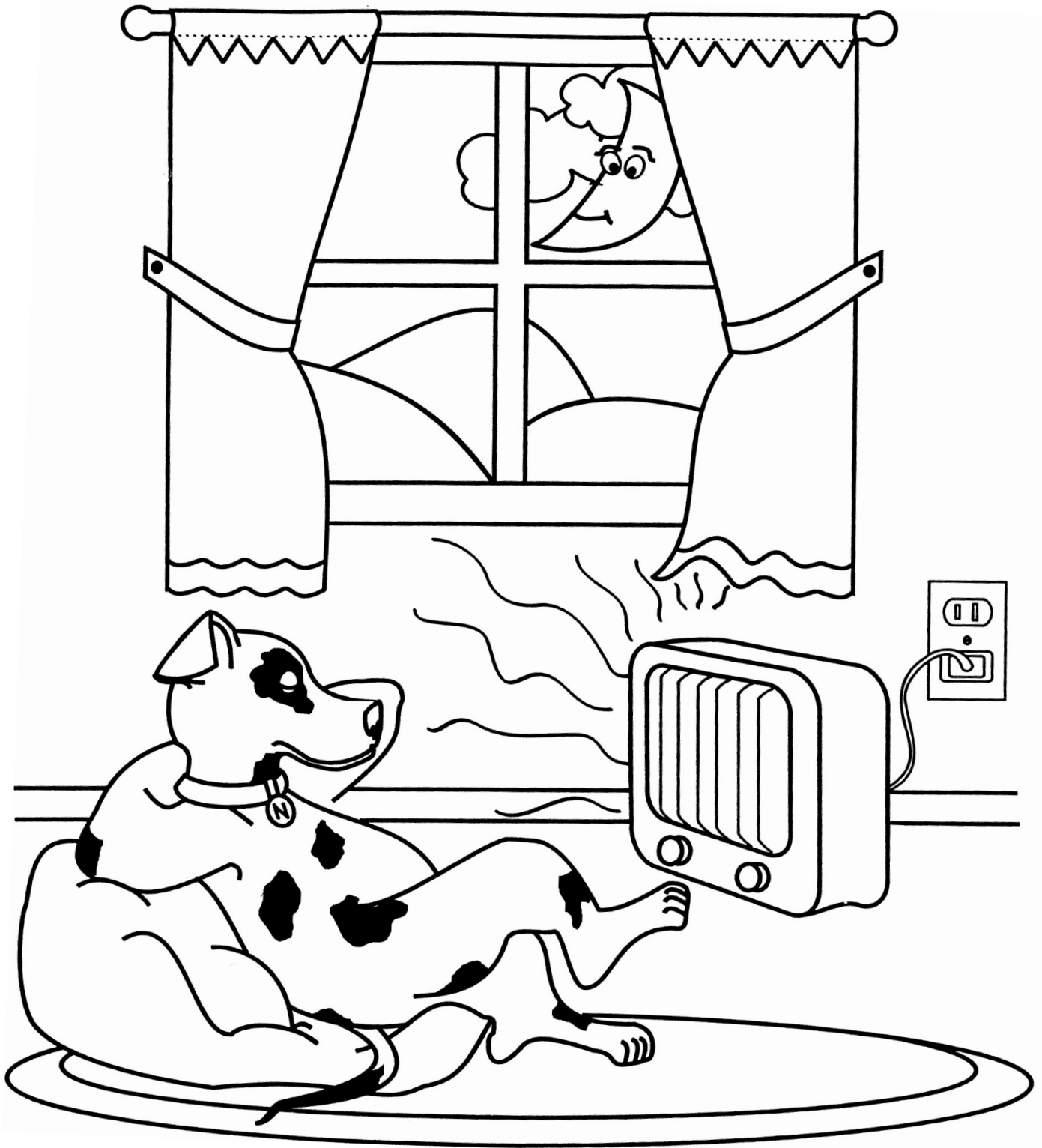




Sam tells Neighbor Ned...

**Avoid the electrical octopus!**

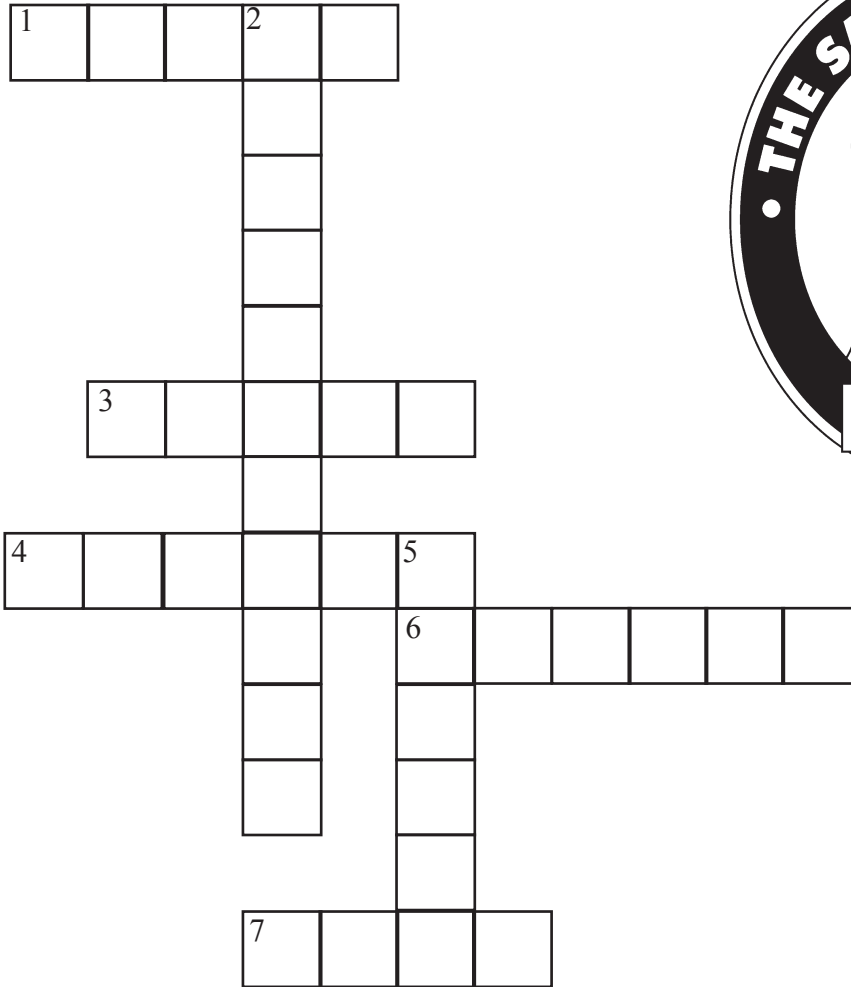
Too many plugs in one outlet can cause a fire.
