Only put plugs in outlets.






Shower without power!


Electricity and water don't mix.

Dry your hands before you touch!


Don't touch switches when in or near water.





Only put food in your toaster!


Knives, forks and electricity don't mix.


Only adults should put out fires!

If a dog chewed it, don't use it!


Frayed cords will shock and start fires.

Don't yank cords from the socket! Use the plug to pull cord from outlet.




Avoid the electrical octopus!
