CHAPTER 50

H.B. No. 1064

An Act relating to dates on which elections authorizing creation of certain hospital districts may be held.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. A general law requiring elections to be held on uniform or specified election dates does not apply to an election held under Section 5, Chapter 199, Acts of the 55th Legislature, Regular Session, 1957 (Article 4494o, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), before September 1, 1985.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
