

CHAPTER 258

H.B. No. 1140

An Act relating to the procedure by which the Department of Public Safety adopts certain rules.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 4a, Chapter 290, Acts of the 53rd Legislature, Regular Session, 1953 (Article 6701d-2, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is repealed.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed by the House on April 18, 1985, by a non-record vote; passed by the Senate on May 15, 1985, by the following vote: Yeas 31, Nays 0.
