CHAPTER 730

H.B. No. 1591

An Act relating to predator control from aircraft in Brooks, Kenedy, and Willacy counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 43.101, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 43.101. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
