CHAPTER 688

H.B. No. 163

An Act relating to information collected by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission concerning public disturbances at places where alcoholic beverages are sold in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Chapter 5, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended by adding Section 5.331 to read as follows:

Sec. 5.331. PUBLIC DISTURBANCE REPORTS. Local law enforcement agencies in each county with a population of 2 million or more shall send to the commission reports and other data concerning shootings, stabbings, and other public disturbances that occur on the premises of a permittee or licensee. The reports and data shall be incorporated into the record of the permittee or licensee. The administrator of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission shall prescribe the form and content of such reports.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 1985.

SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional

rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.
