CHAPTER 397

H.B. No. 1936

An Act relating to the purposes for which revenues from leases for parking beneath freeways are used.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 2a, Chapter 24, Acts of the 48th Legislature, Regular Session, 1943 (Article 1085a, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2a. The governmental agency which holds the title and property rights to land on which a freeway is located may lease for parking purposes the portions of land situated beneath the elevated sections of the freeway. Revenue from a parking lease authorized by this section shall be used for general governmental purposes.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed by the House on May 13, 1985, by the following vote: Yeas 137, Nays 0, 2 present, not voting; passed by the Senate on May 26, 1985, by the following vote: Yeas 31, Nays 0.
