CHAPTER 777

H.B. No. 2478

An Act relating to the validation of notes and deeds of trust issued to finance municipal airport improvements.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. PROCEEDINGS VALIDATED. All governmental acts and proceedings of cities, towns, and municipal airport boards occurring before the effective date of this Act and relating to the authorization and issuance of notes and deeds of trust for municipal airport improvements, including the adoption of any ordinances or resolutions authorizing a note or deed of trust, are validated. The acts and proceedings may not be held invalid because they were not performed in accordance with law.

SECTION 2. EFFECT ON LITIGATION. This Act does not apply to any matter that on the effective date of this Act:

- (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction; or
 - (2) has been held invalid by a final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
