CHAPTER 598

H.B. No. 2520

An Act relating to authority to establish a foreign trade zone at the location of the Saturn automobile production facility.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. The Saturn Trade Zone Corporation, a corporation organized and incorporated under the laws of the State of Texas, is authorized to apply for and accept a grant to establish, operate, and maintain a foreign trade zone at the location designated by General Motors Corporation within the State of Texas for the Saturn automobile production facility, and other subzones, subject to the requirements of federal law and the regulations of the Foreign Trade Zones Board.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
