CHAPTER 43

H.B. No. 531

An Act relating to the notice required for the revision of a subdivision plat.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 2(b), Chapter 846, Acts of the 68th Legislature, Regular Session, 1983 (Article 6626e, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

(b) The notice must be published [for] at least three times within the period beginning on the 30th day and ending on the seventh day [21 days] before the date [day] of the meeting.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 1985, and applies to an application to revise a subdivision plat filed on or after that date. An application filed before the effective date of this Act is subject to the law regarding publication of notices of application that was in existence on the date the application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for this purpose.

SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.
