CHAPTER 251

H.B. No. 718

An Act relating to the notice of a change of nursing home administrators.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 4B, Chapter 413, Acts of the 53rd Legislature, Regular Session, 1953 (Article 4442c, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 4B. CHANGE OF ADMINISTRATORS. If [When] an institution hires a new administrator or person designated as the chief manager, the institution shall notify the Licensing Agency in writing not later than the 30th day after the date on which the change becomes effective and shall pay a \$20 administrative fee.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 1985.

SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.
