## **CHAPTER 325**

## H.B. No. 753

An Act relating to the composition of certain representative districts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. State representative districts 131 and 146 as established by Article II, Chapter 185, Acts of the 68th Legislature, Regular Session, 1983 (Article 195a-8, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), are modified by transferring block 507 of census tract 327.01 from district 131 to district 146.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect beginning with the election of the 70th Legislature, but does not affect the membership, personnel, or districts of the 69th Legislature. If a vacancy occurs in the office of any member of the 69th Legislature affected by this Act and a special election is necessary, the election shall be held in the district as it existed on January 1, 1985.

SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.

Passed by the House on April 25, 1985, by a non-record vote; passed by the Senate on May 17, 1985, by the following vote: Yeas 30, Nays 0.

Effective: Beginning with the election of the 70th Legislature.
