

CHAPTER 845

S.B. No. 1264

An Act relating to the confirmation election for the Coryell City Water Supply District; amending Section 1, Chapter 435, Acts of the 66th Legislature, Regular Session, 1979.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 1, Chapter 435, Acts of the 66th Legislature, Regular Session, 1979, is amended to read as follows:

“Section 1. **CREATION.** Pursuant to Article XVI, Section 59, of the Texas Constitution there is created a conservation and reclamation district in Coryell County, Texas, to be known as the Coryell City Water Supply District, referred to as the district, which shall be a governmental agency and a body politic and corporate [~~subject to approval of the creation at a confirmation election to be called and held by the board of directors before any obligations or bonds of the district are issued, all in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 54, Water Code, including the provisions for notice of the election.~~].”

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed the Senate on April 18, 1985, by the following vote: Yeas 31, Nays 0; passed the House on May 17, 1985, by the following vote: Yeas 134, Nays 0, one present not voting.
