CHAPTER 23

S.B. No. 71

An Act relating to the renewal fee for a license to operate a youth camp; amending Section 2.05, Texas Youth Camp Safety and Health Act (Article 4447I, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 2.05, Texas Youth Camp Safety and Health Act (Article 44471, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2.05. RENEWAL. Licenses issued under this Act shall be renewed annually by submission not later than May 1 of each year of an application for renewal of license on a form provided by the department. The annual fee for such license renewal shall be \$35 [five dollars (\$5)] and shall be submitted with the application for renewal of license."

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed the Senate on January 30, 1985, by the following vote: Yeas 30, Nays 0; passed the House on March 27, 1985, by the following vote: Yeas 141, Nays 1, two present not voting.
