A motor fuel transporter license is not required for a person transporting their own fuel in their own cargo tank for their own use and not for resale.

WHEN TO FILE

This report must be filed on or before the 25th day following the end of a calendar quarter for gasoline or diesel fuel transported during the preceding guarter.
