## CHAPTER 154

H.B. No. 1403

AN ACT

relating to the salary of the bailiff of the 341st District Court.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 53.009(d), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(d) The bailiff appointed by the judge of the 341st District Court is entitled to receive a salary set by the judge in an amount that is commensurate with the salary paid the bailiffs of other courts with similar duties [that does not exceed the salary of a full-time deputy sheriff of the county]. The salary is paid out of the general fund of the county.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 1993.

SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.
