## CHAPTER 66

## H.B. No. 176

## AN ACT

relating to the issuance of specially designed license plates for vehicles owned by certain veterans of military service and surviving spouses of certain veterans.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 5k(g), Chapter 88, General Laws, Acts of the 41st Legislature, 2nd Called Session, 1929 (Article 6675a-5k, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

(g) A vehicle for which Pearl Harbor license plates or[,] Purple Heart license plates are issued under this section is exempt from the motor vehicle registration fee imposed by Section 5 of this Act and any additional county fee imposed under Section 9a of this Act.

SECTION 2. Section 5k(n), Chapter 88, General Laws, Acts of the 41st Legislature, 2nd Called Session, 1929 (Article 6675a-5k, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is repealed.

SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act in the fees required for the issuance of certain license plates applies only to fees for the issuance or renewal of license plates on or after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 4. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
