CHAPTER 101

H.B. No. 298

AN ACT

relating to the election of and appointments to fill vacancies on the board of directors of certain hospital districts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 411, Acts of the 58th Legislature, Regular Session, 1963, is amended by adding Section 3A to read as follows:
- Sec. 3A. (a) A director's election shall be held on the first Saturday in May in each year for the election of the appropriate number of successor directors.
- (b) A vacancy in the office of director shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment by the remaining directors.
- SECTION 2. Chapter 539, Acts of the 63rd Legislature, Regular Session, 1973, is amended by adding Section 3A to read as follows:
- Sec. 3A. (a) A director's election shall be held on the first Saturday in May in each year for the election of the appropriate number of successor directors.
- (b) A vacancy in the office of director shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment by the remaining directors.
- SECTION 3. Chapter 666, Acts of the 64th Legislature, 1975, is amended by adding Section 3A to read as follows:
- Sec. 3A. (a) A director's election shall be held on the first Saturday in May in each year for the election of the appropriate number of successor directors.
- (b) A vacancy in the office of director shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment by the remaining directors.
- SECTION 4. Chapter 667, Acts of the 64th Legislature, 1975, is amended by adding Section 3A to read as follows:
- Sec. 3A. (a) A director's election shall be held on the first Saturday in May in each year for the election of the appropriate number of successor directors.
- (b) A vacancy in the office of director shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment by the remaining directors.
- SECTION 5. Chapter 668, Acts of the 64th Legislature, 1975, is amended by adding Section 3A to read as follows:
- Sec. 3A. (a) A director's election shall be held on the first Saturday in May in each year for the election of the appropriate number of successor directors.
- (b) A vacancy in the office of director shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment by the remaining directors.
- SECTION 6. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the

constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
