

CHAPTER 148

H.B. No. 383

AN ACT

relating to the authority of the Jefferson County Drainage District No. 6 to lease its property

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Chapter 349, Acts of the 57th Legislature, Regular Session, 1961, amended by adding Section 11b to read as follows:

Sec. 11b. The Board of Commissioners may lease any of its property, real or personal, to any person. The lease shall contain terms and provisions that the board determines to be advantageous to the District and to the general public for its use and benefit. The lease may be for any term and may allow a lessee to alter or modify the property, but may not interfere with the concurrent use of the property for drainage and flood control purposes.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
