## CHAPTER 190

## AN ACT

relating to the printing of a statement regarding a health care directive on the reverse side of a driver's license.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Article II, Chapter 173, Acts of the 47th Legislature, Regular Session, 1941 (Article 6687b, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended by adding Section 11D to read as follows:

Sec. 11D. DIRECTIVE TO PHYSICIAN ON REVERSE SIDE OF LICENSE. On the reverse side of each driver's license the Department shall print "Directive to physician has been filed at tel. #" followed by a line that the holder of the license may use to indicate the appropriate telephone number.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 1993.

SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.

Passed by the House on April 7, 1993, by a non-record vote; passed by the Senate on May 10, 1993, by a viva-voce vote.
