CHAPTER 45

H.B. No. 640

AN ACT

relating to an emergency appropriation to the Texas Forest Service to replace equipment and facilities destroyed by fire.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. In addition to amounts previously appropriated for the current fiscal year, the sum of \$200,000 is appropriated for the period ending August 31, 1993, from the general revenue fund to the Texas Forest Service for reconstruction, repair, and equipment replacement required to restore a maintenance shop, tools, and fire suppression equipment that were destroyed by fire on February 25, 1992.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
