

CHAPTER 19

S.B. No. 120

AN ACT

relating to the name of a certain building constructed by the Kerrville State Hospital.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Section 4.081, State Purchasing and General Services Act (Article 601b, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), the Kerrville State Hospital shall name the hospital's patient building completed in 1993 the Luther W. Ross Building in honor of Dr. Luther W. Ross, retired superintendent of the hospital.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed the Senate on February 9, 1993: Yeas 30, Nays 0; passed the House on March 25, 1993: Yeas 128, Nays 0, one present not voting.
