## CHAPTER 727

## S.B. No. 1429

## AN ACT

relating to the rights, powers, privileges, authority, and functions of the Denton County Reclamation and Road District.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 4, Chapter 945, Acts of the 69th Legislature, Regular Session, 1985, is amended to read as follows:

- (a) The district may exercise all of the rights, powers, privileges, authority, and functions conferred by the general law applicable to:
  - (1) levee improvement districts including Chapter 57, Water Code; [and]
  - (2) road utility districts including Chapter 13, Acts of the 68th Legislature, 2nd Called Session, 1984 (Article 6674r-1, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes); and
  - (3) public improvement districts, including the rights, powers, privileges, authority, and functions conferred by Subchapter A; Chapter 372, Local Government Code.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
