S.B. No. 1445

AN ACT

relating to the establishment of fiscal years in certain municipalities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 101, Local Government Code, is amended by adding Section 101.0221 to read as follows:

Sec. 101.0221. FISCAL YEAR FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES. Notwithstanding any fiscal year provision in the city charter, a municipality with a population in excess of 500,000 which is situated in a county bordering the Republic of Mexico may prescribe its fiscal year by ordinance.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.

Passed the Senate on May 4, 1993, by a viva-voce vote; passed the House on May 21, 1993, by a non-record vote.
