NOTICE TO OPERATORS

LEGISLATIVE CHANGE RECONNECT FEE FOR LEASES IN VIOLATION OF COMMISSION RULES WILL BE INCREASING ON <u>SEPTEMBER 1, 2003</u>

The 78th Legislature amended Natural Resources Code 85.167(a) to increase the reconnect fee for any oil lease or gas well that has had a Form P-4 Certificate of Compliance canceled by severance or seal order. Currently, the fee to reconnect a lease or well and reissue a Certificate of Compliance is \$100 per lease. The new legislatively mandated fee will be \$300 per severance/seal order violation. The effective date of this fee increase is September 1, 2003.

If any outstanding severances or seal order violations are not resolved and the \$100 reconnect fee is not paid prior to September 1, 2003, the reconnect fee will be \$300 **per severance/seal order violation**. Any violations remaining unresolved on or after September 1, 2003 where \$100 has been paid will require additional money to completely comply with the increased fee requirements of \$300 per violation.
