## NOTICE TO OPERATORS

## **New Drilling Application Forms Effective Next Month!**

Effective July 1, 2004, the revised Form **W-1** (Application for Permit to Drill, Recomplete, or Re-Enter), along with the Form **W-1D** (Application for Permit to Drill, Recomplete, or Re-Enter **Supplemental Directional Well Information**) and Form **W-1H** (Application for Permit to Drill, Recomplete, or Re-Enter **Supplemental Horizontal Well Information**), for directional and horizontal drills, respectively, will be the approved versions of the drilling permit applications. The primary change in the drilling permit application is the addition of the W-1D and W-1H to allow for more efficient reporting of directional and horizontal drilling data.

The revised forms are available on the Railroad Commission website at <u>http://www.rrc.state.tx.us/divisions/og/form-library/index.html</u>, and through the Commission's Austin office and district offices.

Please note the following concerning the revised Drilling Report Forms:

- Previously required data items such as spacing and density patterns for fields and number of acres in the drilling unit are no longer required because a new automated electronic system will verify this data. The field identification number will be required for each field on the application. Field information, including field number, is now available on-line at the Railroad Commission website at <a href="http://www.rrc.state.tx.us/interactive\_data.html">http://www.rrc.state.tx.us/interactive\_data.html</a>.
- Form W-1, Item 6, Purpose of Filing, now includes "Amended as Drilled (BHL)". This category applies to applications for a vertical well where an Engineering review of the original completion report has determined that an amended W-1 filing is required to reflect bottom hole location.
- Form W-1, Item 13, Surface Location, describes the physical location of the well bore.
- When signing the Form W-1, an E-mail address is optional. However, if it is provided, the E-mail address will become part of the public record.
- When listing fields on the Forms W-1D or W-1H, if the bottom hole/terminus location information is the same for all fields, one can note "ALL FIELDS" in Item 5 and list the location information only once.
