H.B. No. 1031

AN ACT

relating to the anhydrous citric acid content of a mature orange.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 94.022, Agriculture Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 94.022. ORANGES. Oranges are mature when the ratio of soluble solids to the anhydrous citric acid of the juice is at least 9 [12.5] to 1.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 1987.

SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.
