CHAPTER 880

H.B. No. 1270

AN ACT relating to the terms of court of the 70th and 161st District Courts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 24.172(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(b) The terms of the 70th District Court begin on the first Mondays in January [March] and July [September].

SECTION 2. Section 24.258(c), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(c) The terms of the 161st District Court begin on the first Mondays in January [March] and July [September].

SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be 2976

suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed by the House on April 23, 1987, by a non-record vote. Passed by the Senate on May 25, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 30, Nays 0.
