CHAPTER 882

H.B. No. 1311

AN ACT

relating to the supplemental compensation received by certain district judges.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 32.041(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(b) The combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each judge may not exceed an amount equal to \$1,000 less than the combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each justice of the court of appeals in the court of appeals district in which Coke County is located [salary paid by Coke County may not exceed the county's proportionate share of \$8,000 a year, determined by the proportion that the county's population bears to the population of the judicial district].

SECTION 2. Section 32.048(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

- (b) The combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each judge may not exceed an amount equal to \$1,000 less than the combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each justice of the court of appeals in the court of appeals district in which Concho County is located [salary paid by Concho County may not exceed the county's proportionate share of \$8,000 a year, determined by the proportion that the county's population bears to the population of the judicial district].
 - SECTION 3. Section 32.118(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- (b) The combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each judge may not exceed an amount equal to \$1,000 less than the combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each justice of the court of appeals in the court of appeals district in which Irion County is located [salary paid by Irion County may not exceed the county's proportionate share of \$8,000 a year, determined by the proportion that the county's population bears to the population of the judicial district].
 - SECTION 4. Section 32.200(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- (b) The combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each judge may not exceed an amount equal to \$1,000 less than the combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each justice of the court of appeals in the court of appeals district in which Runnels County is located [salary paid by Runnels County may not exceed the county's proportionate share of \$8,000 a year, determined by the proportion that the county's population bears to the population of the judicial district].
 - SECTION 5. Section 32.207(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- (b) The combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each judge may not exceed an amount equal to \$1,000 less than the combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each justice of the court of appeals in the court of appeals district in which Schleicher County is located [salary paid by Schleicher County may not exceed the county's proportionate share of \$8,000 a year, determined by the proportion that the county's population bears to the population of the judicial districts].
 - SECTION 6. Section 32.216(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- (b) The combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each judge may not exceed an amount equal to \$1,000 less than the combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each justice of the court of appeals in the court of appeals district in which Sterling County is located [salary paid by Sterling County may not exceed the county's proportionate share of \$8,000 a year, determined by the proportion that the county's population bears to the population of the judicial district].
 - SECTION 7. Section 32.226(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- (b) The combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each judge may not exceed an amount equal to \$1,000 less than the combined yearly salary from state and county sources received by each justice of the court of appeals in the

court of appeals district in which Tom Green County is located [salary paid by Tom Green County may not exceed the county's proportionate share of \$8,000 a year, determined by the proportion that the county's population bears to the population of the judicial district].

SECTION 8. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
