AN ACT

relating to compliance with the solid waste management service requirements.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 37, Comprehensive Municipal Solid Waste Management, Resource Recovery, and Conservation Act (Article 4477–7c, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 37. COMPLIANCE WITH SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICE RE-QUIREMENTS. Each city and county must comply with Section 12 of this Act not later than December 31, 1989 [1987].

SECTION 2. Section 12, Comprehensive Municipal Solid Waste Management, Resource Recovery, and Conservation Act (Article 4477-7c, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 12. ESTABLISHMENT OF SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICE. Each [eity and] county with a population of more than 30,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal census and each city shall review the provision of solid waste management services in its jurisdiction and shall assure that such services are provided to all persons within its jurisdiction by a public agency or by a private person or persons.

SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed by the House on April 2, 1987, by a non-record vote. Passed by the Senate on May 14, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 30, Nays 0.

Effective August 31, 1987, 90 days after date of adjournment.
