CHAPTER 247

H.B. No. 1756

AN ACT

relating to a foreign trade zone in Travis County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. The city of Austin or a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Texas and designated by the city of Austin is authorized to apply for and accept a grant to establish, operate, and maintain a foreign trade zone in Travis County, and other subzones, subject to the requirements of federal law and the regulations of the Foreign Trade Zones Board.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed by the House on April 23, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 138, Nays 0, 1 present, not voting. Passed by the Senate on May 14, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 30, Nays 0.
