H.B. No. 1927

AN ACT

relating to political subdivisions that may contract for the enforcement of certain warrants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 1(1), Article 6687c, Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

(1) "Political subdivision" means a home-rule city with a population of not less than 380,000, according to the most recent federal census[, and with a council manager form of government].

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed by the House on May 22, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 148, Nays 0, 1 present, not voting. Passed by the Senate on May 30, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 30, Nays 0.
