CHAPTER 631

H.B. No. 2050

AN ACT relating to hunting a golden eagle or Mexican brown eagle.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 64.011, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 64.011. EAGLE. No person may hunt, trap, or kill a golden [Golden] eagle or Mexican brown eagle without first having obtained a permit from the department as provided by Subchapter H, Chapter 43, of this code [may be hunted or trapped in this

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the 2418
