AN ACT

relating to the composition of the Parker County Juvenile Board and to the appointment of an advisory council.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 1040, Acts of the 68th Legislature, Regular Session, 1983 (Article 5139YYYY, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

- Sec. 2. COMPOSITION; ADVISORY COUNCIL. (a) The juvenile board consists of the judges of the county, statutory county, and district courts having jurisdiction in Parker County. The district court judge is the chairman of the board.
- (b) The juvenile board may appoint not more than four volunteers to a citizens' advisory council. Advisory council members serve staggered two-year terms. The advisory council shall meet with the juvenile board at the board's regular quarterly meetings and shall keep the board informed of current community issues relating to juveniles.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.
