AN ACT

relating to the purposes for which funds appropriated to the Southwest Collegiate Institute for the Deaf may be expended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 131.006, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

(c) The board may expend appropriated funds for maintenance and operation, including the maintenance and operation of student housing and food service, unless the funds are specifically restricted to another purpose by the appropriation.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed by the House on March 3, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 135, Nays 2. Passed by the Senate on April 2, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 31, Nays 0.
