AN ACT

relating to certain identifying marks on aircraft owned or leased by the state.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:*

SECTION 1. The State Aircraft Pooling Act (Article 4413(34b), Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes) is amended by adding Section 9A to read as follows:

*Sec. 9A. IDENTIFYING MARKS. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c) of this section, all aircraft owned or leased by the state shall be marked:*

*(1) with the Texas state seal on each side of the aircraft's vertical stabilizer; and*

*(2) with the words "The State of Texas" on each side of the aircraft's fuselage.*

*(b) The board shall, consistent with federal regulations, adopt rules governing the color, size, and location of marks of identification required by this section.*

*(c) This section does not apply to aircraft used for law enforcement purposes.*

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.

Passed by the House on April 9, 1987, by a non-record vote. Passed by the Senate on May 28, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 30, Nays 0.
