

**CHAPTER 572**

**S.B. No. 1454**

**AN ACT**

relating to compensation for judges who are members of the 50th Judicial District Juvenile Board.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:*

**SECTION 1.** Section 5, Chapter 1079, Acts of the 68th Legislature, Regular Session, 1983 (Article 5139JJJJ, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 5. COMPENSATION.** A judge's service on the juvenile board is an additional duty of office. As compensation for their service on the juvenile board and additional

duties imposed on them, the judges who are members of the board shall receive additional compensation of not more than \$6,000 [~~\$1,200~~] per year, payable in 12 equal monthly installments to be paid out of the general fund of the county. Such compensation shall be in addition to all other compensation provided or allowed by law for district, county court-at-law, or county judges.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 1987.

SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.

Passed the Senate on May 14, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 30, Nays 0. Passed the House on May 29, 1987, by a non-record vote.

Approved June 18, 1987.

Effective Sept. 1, 1987.
